**AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PROCEDURES
TO IMPROVE THE HANDLING OF MATTERS IN THE FAMILY COURT
SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 815j of the general statutes be amended to require that:
- 2 (1) An in-person or remote status conference be scheduled not later than
- 3 ten business days following the request for such conference; (2) legal
- 4 fees are reviewed and approved by the court; (3) any party to an action
- 5 make mandatory written disclosure of any change in employment or
- 6 financial status including, but not limited to, compensation of any kind,
- 7 to the opposing party not later than two weeks after the date of the
- 8 change; and (4) the parties to a case shall be responsible for attorney's
- 9 fees based on the percentage difference between each party's adjusted
- 10 gross income as of the date of the last filing with the Internal Revenue
- 11 Service.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve procedures in the family court system.
