## Proposed Bill No. 6505

AN ACT PROHIBITING A MOTORCYCLIST, BICYCLIST OR SKATEBOARD RIDER FROM FILING A CAUSE OF ACTION RELATED TO A BRAIN INJURY UNLESS SUCH PERSON WAS UTILIZING PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR OR A PROTECTIVE HELMET AT THE TIME OF SUCH INJURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-286d of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that a motorcyclist, bicyclist or skateboard rider shall be prohibited from
- 3 filing a cause of action related to a brain injury unless such motorcyclist,
- 4 bicyclist or skateboard rider was utilizing protective headgear or a
- 5 protective helmet at the time of such injury.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit a motorcyclist, bicyclist or skateboard rider from filing a cause of action related to a brain injury unless such motorcyclist, bicyclist or skateboard rider was utilizing protective headgear or a protective helmet at the time of such injury.
