AN ACT CONCERNING UNLAWFUL REMOTE TRACKING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the use of electronic tracking devices to track another person without such person's permission and to create lawful exceptions for the use of such devices, including, but not limited to, by a parent of a minor child, for certain commercial uses and for certain uses of an employer of an employee.
