AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYERS' CHARGEABILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 31-225a of the general statutes be amended to only
- 2 charge an employee's most recent employer's experience account for
- 3 benefits received by such employee, regardless of the duration of time
- 4 such employee has been employed with such employer.

Statement of Purpose:

To make only an employee's most recent employer chargeable for unemployment benefit payments.
