***AN ACT CONCERNING THE PHASING OUT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE
PROPERTY TAX.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to phase out the
- 2 motor vehicle property tax over a period of five years by capping the
- 3 mill rate at twenty-eight in the first year, twenty-four in the second year,
- 4 eighteen in the third year and eleven in the fourth year, and eliminating
- 5 the tax in the fifth year.

Statement of Purpose:

To phase out the motor vehicle property tax over a period of five years.
