AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPIRATION OF CERTAIN LAND USE PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that unless the holder
- 2 of a land use permit seeks and is granted an extension of time, such
- 3 permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance, and any
- 4 associated site plan shall be deemed null and void.
