**AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF RECEIVERS AND
THE EXERCISE OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ENSURE THE CONTINUITY
OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN HOSPITALS FACING FINANCIAL
DISTRESS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize (1) the Attorney
- 2 General to petition the Superior Court for the appointment of a receiver
- 3 to manage hospitals in financial distress or operational crisis, and (2) the
- 4 state to exercise eminent domain to assume control of hospital facilities
- 5 at risk of closure due to financial instability.
