AN ACT ALLOWING DENTISTS TRAINED OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES TO BE LICENSED DENTAL HYGIENISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 379a of the general statutes be amended to allow a 2 dentist trained outside the United States to be licensed as a dental 3 hygienist, provided such dentist (1) possesses a degree of competency 4 and has completed necessary examinations in subjects considered 5 essential for a dental hygienist, as determined by the Commissioner of 6 Public Health, and (2) passes written and practical examinations 7 pursuant to section 20-126j of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a dentist trained outside the United States to apply for licensure as a dental hygienist.
