***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A DATABASE AND HOTLINE FOR THE
REPORTING OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS OR VIOLENT
INCIDENTS OF PATIENTS OF HOME HEALTH CARE WORKERS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the creation of (1) a
- 2 database of the criminal history records of any patient provided home
- 3 health care or hospice care through a home health care agency, hospice
- 4 agency or home health aide, accessible to any worker providing such
- 5 care, and (2) a telephone hotline and Internet web site for individuals to
- 6 report violent incidents involving any patient provided home health
- 7 care that did not result in an arrest and such incidents to be added to
- 8 such database.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure the safety of home health care workers by providing them access to the criminal background information and violent incident reports of their patients.
