**AN ACT ALLOWING THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO  
REVOKE A PHYSICIAN'S LICENSE IF SUCH PHYSICIAN HAS BEEN  
FOUND GUILTY OR CONVICTED OF COMMITTING FERTILITY  
FRAUD.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368a of the general statutes be amended to (1) allow the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health to revoke a physician's license if such
- 3 physician is convicted of committing fertility fraud, regardless of
- 4 whether such physician committed the fertility fraud inside or outside
- 5 the state, and (2) require the commissioner to establish a process
- 6 through which the commissioner may report any such conviction to
- 7 other states where the physician holds a license.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow the Commissioner of Public Health to revoke a physician's license if such physician is convicted of fertility fraud and to require the commissioner to establish a reporting process through which any such conviction may be reported to other states.
