**AN ACT PROHIBITING STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT UNITS FROM
ACCEPTING FEDERAL FUNDS TO CONDUCT CERTAIN PROGRAMS
RELATED TO MARIJUANA GROWN ON PRIVATE LAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 29 and chapter 104 the general statutes be amended to
- 2 prohibit the Division of State Police within the Department of
- 3 Emergency Services and Public Protection, or any other law
- 4 enforcement unit in the state, from accepting federal grant funds to
- 5 conduct any program related to the surveillance of, search for, or
- 6 destruction of marijuana grown on private land.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit law enforcement agencies from engaging in federally funded programs related to the surveillance of, search for, or destruction of marijuana grown on private land.
