***AN ACT CONCERNING ENFORCEMENT OF ADDRESS
VERIFICATIONS FOR SEX OFFENDERS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow sex offender
- 2 registrants to verify their address through a call-in process to the
- 3 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection when the
- 4 United States Postal Service mail is not accessible and allow judicial
- 5 discretion to classify failure to verify an address as an infraction when
- 6 failure to verify is a result of late or lost mail, personal or family illness,
- 7 homelessness or qualifying extenuating circumstances.

Statement of Purpose:

To modernize the address verification process for registry offenders to comply with the law by providing a call-in provision to the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection when United States Postal Service mail is not accessible.
