AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN CANNABIS-RELATED RESTRICTIONS ON STOPS AND SEARCHES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-33p of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the (1) cannabis-related restrictions on a stop or search of a person or
- 3 motor vehicle that are specified in said section, and (2) provisions of said
- 4 section that establish that evidence discovered as a result of any stop or
- 5 search conducted in violation of said section shall not be admissible in
- 6 evidence.

Statement of Purpose:

To give law enforcement officials the ability to stop drivers for cannabis use without certain restrictions.
