AN ACT CONCERNING CRYPTOCURRENCY THEFT AND THE RESOURCES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND PUBLIC PROTECTION TO FIGHT SUCH THEFT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) (A) Define digital 2 currency in the penal code as a monetary instrument in a manner that is 3 consistent with banking definitions; (B) allow preconviction 4 confiscation of digital wallets associated with theft in order to create a 5 victims' compensation fund; and (C) create a hearing process to allow due process that notices the alleged offender who is the holder of the 6 7 digital wallet; and (2) create an operating budget within the Department 8 of Emergency Services and Public Protection to (A) acquire the needed 9 technology to pursue cryptocurrency theft, and (B) support training and 10 communications between local police departments and the Department 11 of Emergency Services and Public Protection.

Statement of Purpose:

To make cryptocurrency theft easier to prosecute, allow for compensation of victims and provide resources to ease the pursuit of such cases to the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection.
