AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPLANTING OF NATIVE AND INDIGENOUS TREES AND SHRUBS ALONG INTERSTATE ROUTE 91 IN THE TOWNS OF ROCKY HILL AND WETHERSFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Department of Transportation replant native and 2 indigenous trees and shrubs along the northbound and southbound 3 sides of Interstate Route 91 from exits 23 to 25, inclusive, and at the 4 median, in the towns of Rocky Hill and Wethersfield.

Statement of Purpose:

To replant native and indigenous trees and shrubs along Interstate Route 91 in the towns of Rocky Hill and Wethersfield to buffer the noise of the highway, address excessive speeding and connect to local pollinator pathways.
