## AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION OF SOUND BARRIERS IN THE CITY OF MERIDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Commissioner of Transportation install sound barriers at the 2 following locations in the city of Meriden: (1) Interstate Route 691 3 eastbound between Hubbard Park and the Chamberlain Highway exit, 4 providing a buffer for residents living on Steuben Street; (2) Interstate 5 Route 91 southbound between the Middletown line and exit 18, Preston 6 Avenue, providing a buffer for residents on Thurrott Avenue; (3) 7 Connecticut Route 15 northbound from the Wallingford line to the 8 Paddock Avenue overpass, providing a buffer for residents on Beth Ann 9 Circle, Royal Oak Circle and Elmwood Drive; and (4) Connecticut Route 10 15 southbound from the Paddock Avenue overpass to the Wallingford 11 line, providing a buffer for residents of Sterling Village and on Prann 12 Court.

## Statement of Purpose:

To install sound barriers at various locations in the city of Meriden to reduce increased traffic noise as a result of the Interstate Route 91, Interstate Route 691 and Connecticut Route 15 interchange improvement project.
