**AN ACT PROTECTING SHORT-TERM CAR RENTAL BUSINESSES
FROM THE AUTOMATED ENFORCEMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE
VIOLATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require the lessee of a
- 2 motor vehicle that is leased for less than thirty days and that is identified
- 3 by an automated traffic enforcement safety device for committing a
- 4 motor vehicle violation to be considered the owner of such motor
- 5 vehicle and responsible for any such violation, and (2) specify that the
- 6 rental car company is not responsible for any such violation.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect businesses that engage in short-term car rentals from the automated enforcement of motor vehicle violations.
