**AN ACT CONCERNING RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES REGARDING THE MUTUAL ENFORCEMENT OF DELINQUENT MOTOR VEHICLE PROPERTY TAXES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to enter into reciprocal agreements
- 3 with other states providing for the mutual enforcement of delinquent
- 4 motor vehicle property taxes so that persons with delinquent motor
- 5 vehicle property taxes in Connecticut may not register a vehicle in such
- 6 other state until such delinquent motor vehicle property taxes are paid
- 7 and vice versa.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to enter into reciprocal agreements with other states regarding the mutual enforcement of delinquent motor vehicle property taxes.
