AN ACT CONCERNING THE CHARGING OF SPEEDING VIOLATIONS OBSERVED BY A SPEED CAMERA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that (1) an infraction 2 issued pursuant to a speed camera violation shall only be issued to the 3 person operating a motor vehicle at the time such vehicle was observed 4 operating in excess of the posted speed limit, (2) a speeding violation 5 shall not be enforced against any person the issuing jurisdiction fails to 6 prove was operating such vehicle at the time such vehicle was observed 7 operating in excess of the posted speed limit, and (3) the issuing 8 jurisdiction shall have the burden of proving the identity of the operator 9 of a motor vehicle observed to be operating in excess of the posted speed 10 limit.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a framework for charging speeding violations observed by a speed camera.
