AN ACT REDUCING STATE FUNDING TO MUNICIPALITIES THAT USE AUTOMATED TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT SAFETY DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to reduce state funding to 2 municipalities that use an automated traffic enforcement safety device 3 pursuant to sections 14-307a to 14-307, inclusive, of the general statutes 4 by an amount equal to the costs associated with such use, including 5 processing and storing images and processing and collecting fines, plus 6 any amount the state would have received if the motor vehicle violation 7 detected by such device was detected by a law enforcement officer and 8 such officer issued a citation.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce state funding to municipalities that use an automated traffic enforcement safety device to detect and collect evidence of alleged motor vehicle violations.
