AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR TINTED WINDOWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-99g of the general statutes be amended to increase the
- 2 penalty for owning a vehicle having a window that has been tinted or
- 3 darkened in violation of said section from an infraction to (1) a fine of
- 4 not less than one hundred dollars nor more than three hundred dollars,
- 5 similar to the fine for reckless driving, or (2) in lieu of a fine, a
- 6 requirement to replace such tinted or darkened window and present
- 7 such vehicle for an inspection at the Department of Motor Vehicles and
- 8 demonstrate compliance with said section.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the penalty for owning a motor vehicle with tinted windows.
