AN ACT PROHIBITING THE INSTALLATION AND SALE OF LIGHT-EMITTING DIODE HEADLIGHTS ON A MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit (1) the installation
- 2 of an aftermarket light-emitting diode headlight on a motor vehicle, (2)
- 3 the sale of an aftermarket light-emitting diode headlight designed for a
- 4 motor vehicle, and (3) the sale of a motor vehicle equipped with light-
- 5 emitting diode headlights.

Statement of Purpose:

To restrict the sale of aftermarket light-emitting diode headlights to enhance roadway safety and limit excessive brightness and glare from oncoming motor vehicles.
