AN ACT CONCERNING PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLIST SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require the Department
- 2 of Transportation to erect signage and implement a public education
- 3 campaign to ensure the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists sharing the
- 4 roadways with vehicles, and (2) develop a framework that permits
- 5 pedestrians to report instances of unsafe driving and use the data from
- 6 such reports to implement traffic enforcement practices and
- 7 technologies to improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety, educate motor vehicle operators and report instances of unsafe driving.
