## AN ACT CONCERNING PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLIST SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require the Department 2 of Transportation to erect signage and implement a public education 3 campaign to ensure the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists sharing the 4 roadways with vehicles, and (2) develop a framework that permits 5 pedestrians to report instances of unsafe driving and use the data from 6 such reports to implement traffic enforcement practices and 7 technologies to improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety.

## Statement of Purpose:

To improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety, educate motor vehicle operators and report instances of unsafe driving.
