## AN ACT STRENGTHENING LAWS CONCERNING EVASION OF POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) section 14-222 of the general statutes concerning negligent 2 homicide with a motor vehicle be amended to raise the penalty for 3 violating said section to a class C or D felony with a mandatory sentence 4 of three to five years, (2) subsection (a) of section 14-223 of the general 5 statutes concerning disobeying the signal of an officer be amended to 6 raise the penalty for violating said subsection to a class A misdemeanor 7 or class E felony, (3) subsection (b) of section 14-223 of the general 8 statutes concerning engaging a police officer in pursuit be amended to 9 raise the penalty to a class E or D felony for a violation not resulting in 10 serious injury or death, (4) section 14-224 of the general statutes 11 concerning evasion of responsibility be amended to provide for a 12 mandatory sentence of two years for causing serious injury to another 13 person and a mandatory minimum sentence of five years for causing the 14 death of another person, and (5) section 53a-57 of the general statutes 15 concerning misconduct with a motor vehicle resulting in death be

- 16 amended to raise the penalty to a class C or B felony with a mandatory
- 17 sentence of five to ten years with the maximum sentence applied for a
- 18 violation resulting in the death of a police officer.

## Statement of Purpose:

To strengthen laws concerning evasion of police.
