**AN ACT PROVIDING HOUSING FOR CERTAIN IMPOVERISHED
VETERANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) authorize one or more
- 2 department heads, as defined in section 4-5 of the general statutes, to
- 3 coordinate in providing a twenty-foot insulated prefabricated home,
- 4 with two bedrooms, a full kitchen and a bathroom, to each veteran
- 5 whose income falls below the federal poverty line and who can
- 6 demonstrate having been without a permanent residence for the
- 7 immediately preceding ninety days, (2) provide for the delivery of such
- 8 prefabricated home to such veteran at any property owned by such
- 9 veteran or by a third party with such third party's consent, and (3)
- 10 require the municipality in which any such property is located, in the
- 11 event such prefabricated home fails to comply with such municipality's
- 12 zoning regulations, to identify an alternative location for such
- 13 prefabricated home not later than sixty days after a determination of
- 14 such noncompliance.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a program for the provision of prefabricated homes to certain impoverished veterans.
