AN ACT CONCERNING A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF ESTABLISHING A FEDERALLY SUBSIDIZED INDUSTRIAL HEMP PROGRAM IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of 2 Economic and Community Development to conduct a feasibility study 3 on the economic impact of establishing a federally subsidized industrial 4 hemp program in the state and report on such study providing 5 recommendations on the establishment of such a program to the joint 6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of 7 matters relating to economic development.

Statement of Purpose:

To consider the economic impact of creating a federally subsidized industrial hemp program in the state.
