**AN ACT CONCERNING A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON THE ECONOMIC
IMPACT OF ESTABLISHING A FEDERALLY SUBSIDIZED
INDUSTRIAL HEMP PROGRAM IN THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Economic and Community Development to conduct a feasibility study
- 3 on the economic impact of establishing a federally subsidized industrial
- 4 hemp program in the state and report on such study providing
- 5 recommendations on the establishment of such a program to the joint
- 6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to economic development.
