## AN ACT REQUIRING THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT TO STUDY HEALTH CARRIER USE OF PRIOR AUTHORIZATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that the Insurance
- 2 Department conduct a study concerning utilization by health carriers of 2 the prior outborization process to dony modically processory health carry
- 3 the prior authorization process to deny medically necessary health care
- 4 treatment, including, but not limited to, the feasibility of requiring a
- 5 limited formulary of prescription drugs or medical services for which
- 6 any health carrier may require prior authorization and any penalties for

## Statement of Purpose:

To require that the Insurance Department conduct a study concerning utilization by health carriers of the prior authorization process to deny medically necessary health care treatment, including, but not limited to, the feasibility of requiring a limited formulary of prescription drugs or medical services for which any health carrier may require prior authorization and any penalties for violating such formulary.
