AN ACT CONCERNING THE REQUIRED NOTICE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PROBATE COURT TO FAMILY MEMBERS UPON THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A CONSERVATOR OF THE ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 45a-649 of the general statutes be amended to (1) require 2 that prior to acting on an application for conservator of the estate of a 3 person, the Probate Court shall personally serve a copy of the application to the following family members of the person for whom the 4 5 conservatorship is sought: The person's parents, siblings and children, who are age eighteen or older; and (2) ensure that all family members 6 7 served with a copy of such application are informed of the possible 8 consequences of the appointment of a conservator as set forth in 9 subsection (b) of section 45a-469 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that family members of a person for whom a conservatorship is sought are made aware of the application for the appointment of a conservator of the estate and the possible consequences of such an appointment.
