AN ACT REQUIRING NOTIFICATION OF PET OWNERS WHEN A VETERINARIAN IS ACCUSED OF ANIMAL NEGLECT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-204a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Public Health to notify the owner of an animal when the
- 3 veterinarian who treats their animal has been accused of animal neglect.

Statement of Purpose:

To assure pet owners are aware of allegations of animal neglect made against their pet's veterinarian.
