AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF NUMBER PLATES TO COMMEMORATE POLLINATOR PATHWAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 246 of the general statutes be amended to provide that 2 (1) the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall issue commemorate 3 number plates of a design to enhance public awareness of the 4 importance of pollinator pathways, and (2) a fee shall be charged for the 5 issuance of such number plates to pay the administrative costs of issuing such number plates and provide funding to organizations in the state 6 7 that conserve and promote native plants and educate the public on 8 pesticides and the impact of pesticides.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a special license plate to enhance public awareness of the importance of pollinator pathways and fund organizations that conserve and promote native plants and educate the public on the impact of pesticides.
