Substitute Bill No. 6843

AN ACT CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF WAGE AND HOUR INVESTIGATORS AT THE LABOR DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2025, the
- 2 Labor Commissioner shall employ not fewer than twenty-two wage and
- 3 hour investigators for the purposes of investigating and ascertaining the
- 4 wages of persons employed in any occupation in the state pursuant to
- 5 section 31-59 of the general statutes.
- 6 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) For the fiscal year ending June 7 30, 2027, and each fiscal year thereafter, the Labor Commissioner shall 8 employ not fewer than forty-five wage and hour investigators for the 9 purposes of investigating and ascertaining wages of persons employed 10 in any occupation in the state pursuant to section 31-59 of the general 11 statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:Section 1from passageNew sectionSec. 2from passageNew section
