AN ACT COMMEMORATING STATE TROOPER IRVING H. NELSON IN THE TOWN OF POMFRET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective October 1, 2025) The Commissioner of
- 2 Transportation shall erect a sign at the intersection of U.S. Route 44 and
- 3 Connecticut Route 169 in the town of Pomfret to commemorate state
- 4 trooper Irving H. Nelson.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
