AN ACT CONCERNING ASSET LIMITS FOR HUSKY C BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) (a) The Commissioner of Social Services shall increase the asset limit for the HUSKY C health program, as defined in section 17b-290 of the general statutes, for (1) an unmarried person from one thousand six hundred dollars to ten thousand dollars, and (2) married persons from two thousand four hundred dollars to fifteen thousand dollars.

(b) Not later than July 1, 2026, the commissioner shall file a report, in
accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
with the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
cognizance of matters relating to appropriations, human services and
aging on (1) the number of persons eligible for the HUSKY C health
program for the prior fiscal year, and (2) any increased costs incurred
by the state that are attributable to changes in the asset limits.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2025	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the HUSKY C asset limit for (1) an unmarried person from one thousand six hundred dollars to ten thousand dollars, and (2) married persons from two thousand four hundred dollars to fifteen thousand dollars.
