## AN ACT REQUIRING NEWBORN SCREENING FOR DUCHENNE MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 19a-55 of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*, 2025):

4 (c) The Commissioner of Public Health shall publish a list of all the 5 abnormal conditions for which the department screens newborns under 6 the newborn screening program, which shall include, but need not be 7 limited to, testing for (1) amino acid disorders, including 8 phenylketonuria, organic acid disorders, fatty acid oxidation disorders, 9 including, but not limited to, long-chain 3-hydroxyacyl CoA 10 dehydrogenase (L-CHAD) and medium-chain acvl-CoA 11 dehydrogenase (MCAD), hypothyroidism, galactosemia, sickle cell 12 disease, maple syrup urine disease, homocystinuria, biotinidase 13 adrenal hyperplasia, deficiency, congenital severe combined 14 immunodeficiency disease, adrenoleukodystrophy, spinal muscular 15 atrophy and any other disorder included on the recommended uniform

- 16 screening panel pursuant to 42 USC 300b-10, as amended from time to
- 17 time, and as prescribed by the Commissioner of Public Health, [and] (2)
- 18 on and after July 1, 2025, cytomegalovirus, and (3) on and after July 1,
- 19 <u>2027, Duchenne muscular dystrophy</u>.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Purpose:

To require newborn screening for Duchenne muscular dystrophy.
