AN ACT ALLOWING A TOWN TO DESIGNATE ITSELF A CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 7-101 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

- 3 (a) A town may, by vote of its legislative body, designate itself a city.
- 4 (b) Each town <u>or city</u> shall provide itself with a seal with the name of 5 the town <u>or city</u> and the state and the word "seal" inscribed thereon and 6 may place thereon any such other suitable inscription or design as it 7 determines. If any town <u>or city</u> changes any design or inscription upon 8 its seal, a certificate describing such change shall be made and filed by 9 the town clerk of such town <u>or city</u> with the Secretary of the State. The 10 town clerk shall have the custody of such seal.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
