## Substitute Bill No. 6957

## AN ACT ALLOWING A TOWN TO DESIGNATE ITSELF A CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 7-101 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):
- 3 (a) A town may, by vote of its legislative body, designate itself a city.
- 4 Any town that designates itself a city pursuant to this section shall be
- 5 deemed a consolidated town and city for the purposes of the general
- 6 statutes.
- 7 (b) Each town or city shall provide itself with a seal with the name of
- 8 the town or city and the state and the word "seal" inscribed thereon and
- 9 may place thereon any such other suitable inscription or design as it
- determines. If any town <u>or city</u> changes any design or inscription upon
- its seal, a certificate describing such change shall be made and filed by
- 12 the town clerk of such town <u>or city</u> with the Secretary of the State. The
- town clerk shall have the custody of such seal.

This act shall take effect as	follows and shall amend the following
