## AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR NUTRITION ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 17b-791 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2025*):

3 (a) The Department of Social Services shall establish a supplemental 4 nutrition commodities assistance program to provide funds for the 5 purchase of <u>produce</u>, high protein <u>foods</u> or other nutritionally beneficial 6 supplemental foods [, or both,] for soup kitchens, food pantries and 7 emergency shelters. Such foods shall be purchased in bulk by [the 8 Connecticut Food Bank] Connecticut Foodshare through in-state 9 wholesalers or brokers, or both, and allotted to existing soup kitchens, 10 food pantries and emergency shelters in accordance with the established 11 policies of [the Connecticut Food Bank] Connecticut Foodshare.

12 (b) At least fifteen per cent of funds appropriated for the program 13 pursuant to section 2 of this act shall be used to purchase produce or 14 other products from state farmers. Within available appropriations, 15 funds appropriated pursuant to section 2 of this act shall be increased 16 not less than three per cent each fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026. Such 17 soup kitchens, food pantries and emergency shelters [shall pay] may be 18 charged a handling [charge of] fee of up to five cents per pound in order 19 to cover the costs incurred by [the Connecticut Food Bank] Connecticut 20 <u>Foodshare</u>. The food shall be distributed free of charge by the soup

21 kitchens, food pantries and emergency shelters.

Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2025*) The sum of ten million dollars is appropriated to the Department of Social Services from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, for the supplemental nutrition commodities assistance program established pursuant to section 17b-791 of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Legislative Commissioners:

In Section 1(b), "<u>in each fiscal year</u>" was removed from the first sentence concerning allocation of fifteen per cent of funds for accuracy and internal consistency, and "<u>Connecticut farmers</u>" was changed to "<u>state farmers</u>" for consistency with standard drafting conventions.
