AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF HEALTH CARRIER COVERAGE GUIDELINES, UTILIZATION REVIEW AND COVERAGE FOR LIFE-SAVING MEDICAL TREATMENT OR SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Insurance Commissioner 2 shall conduct a study of: (1) Health carrier coverage guidelines in this 3 state as compared to the most recent evidence-based coverage 4 guidelines in other states; (2) utilization review transparency measures 5 by health carriers and the feasibility of revising certain time limits for 6 health carriers to conduct utilization review of nonurgent and urgent 7 care requests; and (3) mandated health insurance coverage for life-8 saving medical treatment or services, unless medical evidence justifies 9 denial of such coverage. For the purposes of this section, "health carrier" 10 has the same meaning as provided in section 38a-1080 of the general 11 statutes, and "utilization review" has the same meaning as provided in 12 section 38a-591a of the general statutes.

(b) Not later than February 1, 2026, the Insurance Commissioner shall
report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general

- 16 having cognizance of matters relating to insurance on the findings of
- 17 such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require that the Insurance Commissioner conduct a study of: (1) Health carrier coverage guidelines in this state as compared to such coverage guidelines in other states; (2) utilization review transparency measures and time limits concerning utilization review of nonurgent and urgent care requests; and (3) mandated health insurance coverage for life-saving medical treatment or services.
