AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CAUSE OF ACTION FOR TORTIOUS INTERFERENCE WITH THE RIGHT OF AN INHERITANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2025) (a) An action for tortious
- 2 interference with the right of an inheritance may be brought when (1) a
- 3 person has an expectation of receiving an inheritance, (2) another person
- 4 has knowledge of the expected inheritance, (3) such other person
- 5 engages in conduct that demonstrates an intent to interfere with the
- 6 expected inheritance, (4) such other person's conduct was tortious
- 7 causing the expected inheritance to fail, and (5) the person bringing the
- 8 action suffered actual economic loss as a result of such other person's
- 9 tortious conduct.
- 10 (b) Any person aggrieved by acts constituting tortious interference
- 11 with the right of an inheritance may bring an action in the Superior
- 12 Court to recover damages, together with costs and a reasonable
- 13 attorney's fee. No such action shall be brought under this section but
- within three years from the date of the act complained of.
