AN ACT ESTABLISHING A WORKING GROUP TO STUDY WAYS TO FUND A UNIVERSAL FREE SCHOOL MEALS PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) There is established a working 2 group to study ways to fund a universal free school meals program that would assist public schools to provide free breakfasts and lunches to all 3 4 public school students. The study shall examine (1) the amount of 5 funding projected to be required for such program, (2) possible sources 6 for funding, including, but not limited to, the imposition of a dedicated 7 tax or fee, (3) the parameters for the establishment of such program and 8 for disbursement of funds, and (4) any other matters relevant to the

establishment or funding of such program.

- 10 (b) The working group shall consist of (1) the chairpersons of the joint 11 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of 12 matters relating to finance, revenue and bonding, education, children 13 and public health, (2) representatives of public schools and local or 14 regional boards of education, (3) public health or nutrition experts, and 15 (4) any other individuals or entities the chairpersons deem desirable or 16 necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.
 - (c) The chairpersons of said joint standing committees shall jointly schedule the first meeting of the working group, which shall be held not

- 19 later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
- 20 (d) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
- 21 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance,
- 22 revenue and bonding shall serve as administrative staff of the working
- 23 group.
- 24 (e) Not later than January 1, 2026, the working group shall submit a
- 25 report on its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly,
- in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.
- 27 The working group shall terminate on the date that it submits such
- 28 report or January 1, 2026, whichever is later.
