## RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL RIGHTS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

1 That article first of the Constitution be amended to provide that (1) 2 each person shall have an individual right to clean and healthy air, 3 water, soil, ecosystems and environment and a safe and stable climate 4 for the benefit of public health, safety and the general welfare, (2) the 5 state shall not infringe upon said rights and shall protect these rights 6 equitably for all people regardless of race, ethnicity, tribal affiliation, 7 gender, socioeconomic status or geography, (3) the state shall serve as 8 trustee of all of the natural resources of this state, including its waters, 9 air, flora, fauna, soils and climate, and shall conserve, protect and 10 maintain these resources for the benefit of all people, including present 11 and future generations, (4) any funds supporting the state in its 12 obligations as trustee as stated shall not be diverted for nontrust 13 purposes, and (5) the rights stated are equivalent to all other inalienable 14 rights and may be directly invoked and enforced by the residents of this 15 state.
