RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION CONCERNING AN INDIVIDUAL RIGHT TO CLEAN AND HEALTHY AIR, WATER, SOIL, ECOSYSTEMS AND ENVIRONMENT AND A SAFE AND STABLE CLIMATE.

Resolved by this Assembly:

1 That article first of the Constitution of the state be amended to 2 provide that each person shall have an individual right to clean and 3 healthy air, water, soil, ecosystems and environment and a safe and 4 stable climate for the benefit of public health, safety and the general 5 welfare.

To propose an amendment to the State Constitution to provide each person with an individual right to clean and healthy air, water, soil, ecosystems and environment and a safe and stable climate for the benefit of public health, safety and the general welfare.
