***RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE
CONSTITUTION CONCERNING TERM LIMITS FOR THE OFFICE OF
GOVERNOR.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to provide that (1) no
- 2 person shall be elected to the office of Governor more than twice, and
- 3 (2) no person who has held the office of Governor, or acted as Governor,
- 4 for more than two years of a term to which another person was elected
- 5 to said office shall be elected to the office of Governor more than once.

Statement of Purpose:

To propose a constitutional amendment to impose term limits on the
office of Governor.
