***RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE  
CONSTITUTION CONCERNING TERM LIMITS FOR THE EXECUTIVE  
BRANCH CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to provide that (1) no
- 2 person shall be elected to an executive branch constitutional office more
- 3 than twice, and (2) no person who has held an elected executive branch
- 4 constitutional office, or acted as said officer, for more than two years of
- 5 a term to which another person was elected to said office shall be elected
- 6 to said executive branch constitutional office more than once.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To propose a constitutional amendment to impose term limits on the executive branch constitutional officers.
