RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION INCREASING THE LEGISLATIVE TERM OF OFFICE AND IMPOSING TERM LIMITS ON MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That section 10 of article third of the Constitution of the state be
- 2 amended to increase the term of office for members of the General
- 3 Assembly from two years to four years and to provide that no senator
- 4 or representative shall serve more than two terms in such office.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the term of office for legislators from two years to four years and to impose a term limit of two terms.
