RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CONCERNING THE RIGHT TO VOTE IN MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS FOR CERTAIN LAWFUL PERMANENT RESIDENTS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to grant lawful
- 2 permanent residents, who are authorized to work in the United States
- 3 and have been residents of the state for at least five years, the right to
- 4 vote in municipal elections, including for local boards of education.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow certain lawful permanent residents to vote in municipal elections.
