RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CULTURE AND HERITAGE OF TAÍNO DESCENDANTS IN THIS STATE.

Resolved by this House:

1 That the House recognize the residents of this state of Taíno heritage, 2 by (1) affirming their vital role in the state's diverse cultural fabric, (2) 3 honoring the historical and cultural contributions of the Taíno people, 4 ensuring that their heritage is recognized and preserved for future 5 generations, (3) supporting efforts of the Taíno people to gain federal 6 recognition while clarifying that this recognition does not confer tribal 7 status, nor establish claims to land or sovereignty within the state, and 8 (4) encouraging collaboration with Taíno cultural organizations to 9 promote awareness, support educational initiatives and assist in 10 language revitalization efforts.

Statement of Purpose:

To respect and affirm the cultural identity of Taíno descendants in Connecticut, ensuring that their heritage is recognized and preserved for future generations while fostering a greater understanding of their historical and ongoing contributions to the state.
