AN ACT PROHIBITING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AND ARBITRATION AGREEMENTS FROM CONFLICTING WITH STATE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 5-278 of the general statutes be amended to repeal the
- 2 provision permitting the terms of collective bargaining agreements and
- 3 arbitration agreements to prevail over any conflicting provision of the
- 4 general statutes, a public or special act or an agency regulation.

Statement of Purpose:

To require collective bargaining agreements and arbitration agreements to comply with the provisions of state law.
